

REQUIREMENTS FOR REPORT THESES DRAWIN UP

Report theses shall be submitted in Russian or English languages.

Their volume shall not exceed 5 A4 pages including annotation, text, tables, images and bibliography.

The index UDK shall be indicated in the left top corner of the page.

The name of thesis shall be typed in capitals in the middle of the page. The list of authors with indication of their employment place, city, country and e-mail shall be placed below the title.

Thesis materials shall be printed on the laser printer, one-sided, with the font Times New Roman 13 pt, interval 1 in the text editor Microsoft Word.

Text shall be printed on the white paper A4 (210x297) mm, margins are as follows: Top and bottom - 20 mm, left and right - 25 mm.

Formulas shall be Microsoft Equation objects, separated from main text and numerated in round brackets.

Images shall be done with Corel Draw, AutoCAD.

Bibliographical references in the text (bibliography) shall be listed according to the GOST 7.1 -2003.

Report theses shall be submitted in 1 hard copy signed by authors as well as in electronic form.
